

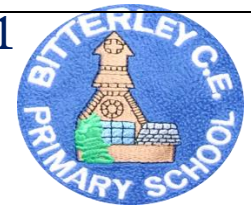

Coming soon – TESCO appeal

We have been accepted for the TESCO 'Bags of Help' scheme. From the 1st July you will see our appeal for support with the building of a school amphitheater. The 'token voting' system with our project on will appear in the Ludlow store.

Bags of Help is Tesco's exciting local community grant scheme where the money raised from the 5p bag charge is being used to fund thousands of local projects in communities right across the UK.

Launched in 2015, Bags of Help sees charities and community organisations awarded grants to fund local projects.

The way that it works: Three community projects in each local area are voted on by customers in the Tesco store, with projects changing every other month. Following the vote, the project that received the most votes in its area will receive a grant of up to £4,000, second place receiving up to £2,000 and third place up to £1,000.

Customers are given a token when they buy their shopping that they can use to make their choice using the voting units in most stores.

Thank you to all those who supported our lunch this year. We had over 40 dads/granddads/uncles turn up!



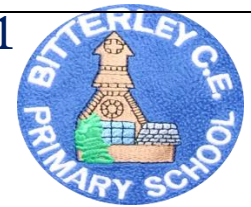

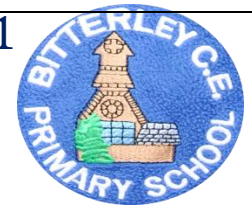

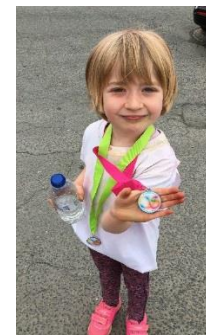
Well done to both Mary and Lewis for gaining their ASA Duckling Award 1.

Many congratulations to James who received a trophy for being the Players Player 2016 – 2017 with Ludlow Town Football Club.



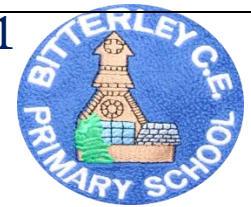
