Dear Parents and Carers,

We come to the end of another week of wider opening in school. Because of current restrictions we are only able to plan in blocks of 2 weeks. For the next two weeks, from the 22<sup>nd</sup> June, we are accepting some more, (limited), numbers of children. We are going to offer some time in school for Year 3 children, (in addition to Critical Worker, Nursery, Foundation, Year 1 and Year 6 children). This would mean that we would have had some children from every class in school before the end of term. There is no expectation from Government that we must do this, however we feel it important to do all that we can with the resources available to us.

So from next week all available spaces in school will be in use including the hall which is in use as a 6<sup>th</sup> classroom for all of our Critical Worker families. Nevertheless, we know that all developments are subject to change – we are still receiving varying guidance on a regular basis. Although we are seeing promising signs of change allowing the lockdown to be gradually eased it is true to say that vigilance is still vital.
