Dear Parents and Carers,

So we come to the end of another busy (in a very different way to normal) week. Yesterday schools received guidance on the reopening of schools from September. The document is 18,009 words long! It is going to take some time to digest and then formulate a plan but we will let you know what the plan is in due course. We will avoid rushing into any decisions. One thing is for sure, the PLAN is to have all children back in school in September. Somethings should restart straight away such as the use of buses. Other things will be some time yet – assemblies for example.

The Summer Term will end on Thursday 16th July in a much quieter manner than usual. Unfortunately, despite promises, no further funding to cover costs of provision over the Summer has materialised. As you will have seen in the media, schools across England will not remain open during the summer holidays for the children of key workers. Both the Shropshire Local Authority and the Multi Academy Trust have stated that they do not expect any school to be open over the summer break. Whilst this is a source of great sadness for us, we know that the most important thing is that we do all that we can to keep our community safe.
