


Each day starts at 9am and finished at 3.30pm and costs £25 per child.

#### <u>School Meals – a message from Shires</u>

Shire Services would like to reassure parents that we have everything covered so we can continue to feed your children safely in September. 

On 16th July 2020 we successfully raised £2,873 with 218 supporters in 42 days















As you are aware all uniform orders can be placed on-line at <a href="www.schoolwearfactory.co.uk">www.schoolwearfactory.co.uk</a>.
