

### English

We are learning to write dialogue within a journey story, openings and endings of stories, a persuasive text and an explanation text. The stories The Papaya That Spoke and The True Story of The Little Pigs.

### Maths

Year 3 will focus on fractions, money, time, shape and statistics. Year 4 will focus on decimals, money, time, shape, statistics, and position and direction. Additionally, children will continue to practise their rapid recall of multiplication facts up to the twelve timetables.

### Science

We will be looking at the human body. We will study the parts of the digestive system, what happens to the food we eat, the intestines, our major bones, types of teeth, and how we ensure that we are eating a balanced diet. Additionally, we will study food chains and identifying predators and prey.

### Music

The children will be learning how does music connect us with our planet and how does music connect us with our past. The class will be exposed to a range of genres including gospel, hip-hop and folk song. Additionally, children will learn to play the recorder.

### Physical Education

This term we will be focusing on athletics and rounders. We will practise our running and throwing (javelin, shotput, discus).

### History

Fantastic Firs will use a range of historical sources to learn about the Egyptians. We will focus on Egyptian society, the importance of the River Nile, travel, trade, beliefs about afterlife and who built the pyramids.

### Computing

Fantastic Firs will learn to programme games. They will learn to apply loops to create repetition. Pupils will design their own games and evaluate this by debugging any problems.

### Geography

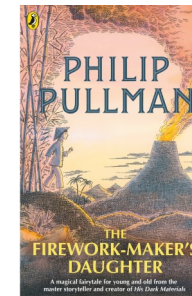
