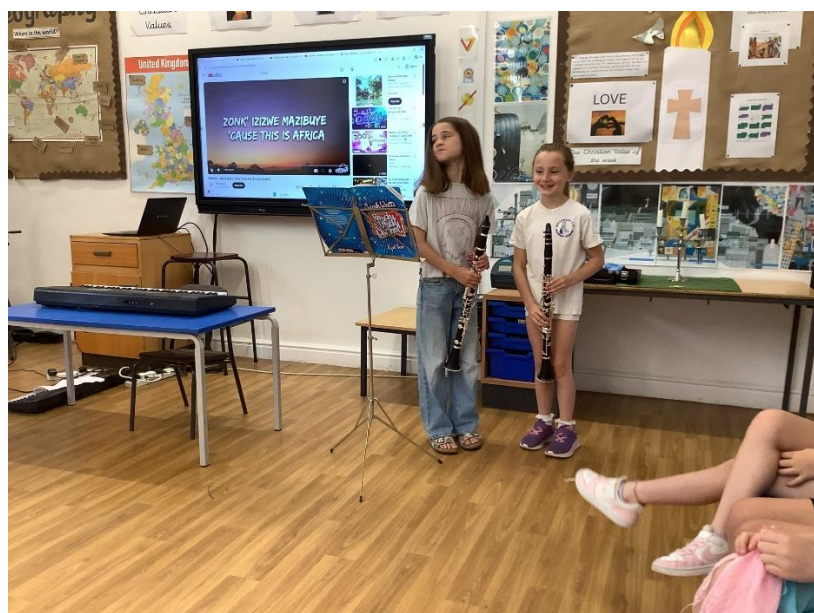
Year 6 leavers
